

## Association of Independent Doctors makes video satirizing price transparency

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The Association of Independent Doctors made a <u>video</u> satirizing the lack of price transparency in healthcare called "The Perfect Money Making Model," according to the <u>Orlando Sentinel.</u>

The video outlined 10 steps it claims hospitals and health systems take to improve their bottom lines at the expense of consumers:

- 1. Take the matter out of consumers' hands
- 2. Let third parties control cost negotiation and care delivery.
- 3. Convince consumers that insurers can spend money more effectively than consumers.
- 4. Make the pricing structure overly complicated.
- 5. Inflate retail prices to convince consumers insurers are getting them a deal.
- 6. Keep prices hidden.
- 7. Only provide price after services are rendered.
- 8. Send consumers to collections if bills are unpaid.
- 9. Obstruct potential legislation that might disrupt the system.
- 10. Avoid paying taxes by declaring nonprofit status.
